

Art & Design, Design and Technology and Music

Our Design and Technology topic will fit in nicely with our Humanities topic as we will be making Punch and Judy puppets.

In Music we will be exploring Sea Shanties and looking at pitch. In the second half of term we will be listening to Carnival of the Animals.

In Art we will be exploring patterns in nature and making prints of natural objects in clay.

PE

In PE this term we will be preparing for sports day. We will be practising a range of athletic based skills including running, javelin, speed bounce, hurdles as well as dribbling a football. We will also be learning how to hit and strike a ball in tennis.

Maths

This term we continue to cover addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will use the knowledge we already have to help us solve one and two step problems. We will continue to develop mental calculation strategies and think about how we can use these to help us solve problems.

Geography and History

This term we will find out about how the seaside has changed in past generations. We will be learn about the different features in our local environment and compare these to features found at the seaside; thinking about both the human and physical elements.

PSHE & RE

RE This term we will be exploring questions that prompt discussion, we will be encouraging children to develop a point of view and accept other people's opinions.

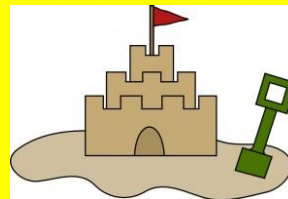

ICT

English

Science

In Science we will be finding out about how plants and animals are suited to their habitats.
