

### **Art & Design, Design and Technology and Music**

During Art and Design we will focus on Henri Rousseau who created the piece 'Tiger in a Tropical Storm' we will explore his work and use this as inspiration for creating our own works of Art.

In D&T we will find out about healthy food types and will design and make our own fruit salads.

In Music we will be exploring rhythm and duration using un-tuned percussion. We will play a variety of rhythm patterns including Samba. Later in the term we will compose pieces and use graphic scores to record them.

### **Maths**

This term we continue to explore addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

The children will use their to help us solve one and two step problems. We will continue to develop mental calculation strategies and think about how we can use these to help us solve problems.

### **ICT**

This term we will focus on 'Talking and sharing' this will include discussing how to be safe on the internet. The children will learn how to communicate safely and think about the different ways we can send messages. They will also begin to understand that technology can help us to send a message a long way very quickly.

### **English**

In English we will focus on stories by a particular author and the children will create a piece of writing inspired by the author. In our Poetry and Pattern and Rhyme units, the children will also learn how to build vocabulary, experiment with language and re-create the poem 'Tiger Tiger'.

The 'Explanation' topic will involve comparing two different books and explaining their reasons why they are different. The children will be read a story from a Fantasy genre and they will learn how to sequence events and write a book review based around the class novel.

### **Geography**

In Geography we will focus on the environment of a rainforest and what animals inhabit there, explore counties that are near the equator and for our MFL day we will learn all about Brazil. KS1 will also visit Kew Gardens as part of our Rainforest unit of work.

### **History**

Our History topic this term will explore a famous Artist from the past where the children will learn about the Artist's life and the significance of their work.

### **PE**

The children will learn different ways of travelling such as running, walking, hopping as well as teaching the children different ways of throwing. We will also explore how to accurately aim at a target when using a bat and ball. This term the children will visit the local swimming pool where they will be taught in small groups. The children will visit the pool within their class groups.

### **PSHE & RE**

In PSHE we will explore the topics 'Relationships' and 'Changes' by discussing who is important to us and what makes us proud to be an individual. We will focus on different solutions to resolve a variety of issues such as hurting someone feelings. We will also focus on the importance of having rules, how rules keep us safe and how changes can sometimes be difficult.

This term we will focus on 'Special places' and 'Signs and Symbols' during RE. We will focus on the special places that Christians may wish to visit as well as consider our own special places. The children will also explore the meaning behind religious celebrations, describe what messages and meanings are expressed through some symbols.

### **Science**

Our topics for this term will be 'Growing Plants' and 'Human Growth'. We will focus on identifying the different parts of the plant and the importance of looking after a growing plant. The children will be comparing different plants growth and creating their own investigations to solve questions. During the 'Human growth' topic we will identify the different body parts of the human body, explore how humans grow and what we need to stay healthy.
