Access to clubs, music tuition, day trips & school journeys	£1000	Disadvantaged pupils will be able to participate in a broader more enriched curriculum. This will enhance life skills & experiences.
Achievement for All scheme	£3000	All children will have more opportunities to achieve expected progress. External advice and support will be monitored and reviewed by SLT. Provision, progress & attainment will be reviewed and appropriate targets set and reviewed to monitor.
Additional phonics resources for use throughout the school	£400	Resources are of a better quality to ensure these are used to support the learning of phonics & spelling across the school
Additional resources for Reading scheme for children to access	£400	For children to have a wider breadth of reading material to ensure they develop early reading skills at a more rapid rate
Additional visual resources for Maths to use in intervention groups	£400	Higher quality of resources to use to support the learning of the ppm children who are at risk of not making good progress in maths
G&T opportunities for able writers, readers & mathematicians	£400	Children will be given opportunities to develop and enhance their curriculum knowledge through events. They will reach GDS in maths, reading or writing
Learning Support Assistant to work alongside the SEN team to enhance the provision for these children	£1000	Teaching assistants will be upskilled in their ability to support the learning of specific groups of children LSA will support the monitoring and targeted impact for these children

Learning Support Assistant time to create a bank of resources for parents to access to support their children at home	£300	Parents will gain knowledge to be able to support their children more effectively at home
LSA, DHT & SenCo time for pupil voice linked to PPG children's individual pupil trackers	£3000	Children will have opportunities to share thoughts about their learning and have a better understanding of what is required of them to make better progress towards their targets
Maths booster for year 5 & 6 children	£1500	Targeted support to identify gaps in learning in years 5 & 6. Focused individualised learning to ensure these children develop their confidence and focus in lessons.
Mindfulness training for parents	£500	Parents will gain knowledge in how to support the emotional needs of their children.
Nurture room to be set up to support children with emotional needs	£500	Vulnerable children will have a safe place to go and professional support when needed
Parental workshops for parents of children in the Foundation Stage to develop attachment awareness to support the children in their 0-5 years	£300	Parents will be able to support their children better emotionally therefore ensuring they are more able and ready to learn
Parental workshops to develop awareness of parenting skills to support children ready to learn	£500	Parents will know how to support their children emotionally
Protective behaviours – training, time & resources for key staff member	£300	Children will have the opportunity to be supported with their emotional needs to ensure they are emotionally stable to concentrate better on their learning
Pupil progress meetings including all relevant staff to discuss and track progress and set targets for moving forward	£3000	SLT members to lead pupil progress meetings every half term. All staff to be involved to discuss positive interventions and next steps for the children
Targeted 1:1 provision for Maths through 3 <sup>rd</sup> space learning	£1500	Children at risk of not meeting age related expectations in Maths will be given opportunity to learn specific targeted maths they need to ensure their learning gaps are filled
Targeted intervention across the school for children who at risk of not meeting age related expectations or appropriate progress This intervention to include Reading, Writing & Maths	£21,000	Eligible children will have better opportunity to reach age related expectations The gap between disadvantaged and other pupils will be diminished Staff training will ensure development of staff expertise to ensure children's needs are met SLT regularly monitor trends in data to inform school development plan
Targeted Maths & English boosters for children in Year 5 during the summer term	£1,000	To ensure any gaps in learning are identified so that children have better opportunity to reach age related expectations

Targeted maths specific intervention for children at risk of not meeting age related expectations at the end of the year	£1500	Higher percentage of vulnerable children to reach age related expectations by the end of the year
Targeted SEMH support – protective behaviours, anxiety awareness, mindfulness	£2000	Children will feel emotionally settled to learn
Targeted work for secondary transition for children with SEMH needs	£750	Children will have a smoother transition to secondary school ensuring they are better prepared for the impact
To enhance the opportunities for children to access a broad curriculum giving them opportunities to participate in workshops & curriculum events	£400	Children will be given more opportunities to be part of an enriched, broad and balanced curriculum
Training for staff to support the work of protective behaviours, mindfulness & nurture	£1500	More vulnerable children will be emotionally secure to enable them to make better progress in their learning
