At Wheatcroft Primary School we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the children. In addition, it is considered that an innovative and varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all children.

We will monitor the impact of the funding available against the following 5 indicators

1. the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick starting healthy active lifestyles
2. the profile of PE & Sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all teaching staff in teaching PE & Sport
4. broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils within their school experience
5. increased participation in competitive sport

The timing of pupil premium grant funding has not aligned with the normal school accounting year and at times elements of the funding based on pupil numbers has been retrospective. This means that elements of the spending may be “planned” or “completed” in these monitoring tables.

Engagement summary 16/17 <i>Updated February 2017</i>	<p>During the 2016/17 calendar/ financial year Wheatcroft have engaged in 22 strands of activity with the sports partnership. This has included 4 subject leader training sessions and 3 staff training opportunities including a whole staff Inset session. 20 sessions directly engaging children have taken place including tournaments and sports-hall competitions & Sports / play leader training. These are in addition to the ongoing sporting clubs which operate during and after the school day and the regular fixtures from the inter-school friendly leagues. In addition to whole class engagement, targeted implementation of a daily mile opportunity has been facilitated by our sports apprentice for nominated children.</p> <p>During the period the School has been in receipt of the Gold Active Sports Award. The breadth of experiential activity offered to our children has never been greater and the ongoing engagement with team games and sports has been sustained.</p>
