

Appendix C: Covid-19 arrangements

At Wheatcroft we are proud of our pupils' attitudes to behaviour and their learning. We have added this appendix to our behaviour policy to reflect the expectations we have for all pupils when attending school during this period. Should pupils deliberately disobey these rules they will no longer be able to attend school.

Additional Behaviour Expectations:

- To tell an adult if you are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- To follow any altered routines for arrival or departure e.g. only enter and exit the school building from the designated doors
- To move around the school as per specific instructions
- To follow the social distancing rules in class and in the playground
- To behave well at all times to maintain the safety of all pupils
- To follow instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school
- To follow amended expectations about break or lunch times, including where pupils may or may not play
- To follow rules about sharing any equipment or other items
- To follow procedures around the use of toilets
- To follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising
- To follow expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoid touching mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- To follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser
- To follow clear rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person
- To follow expectations for remote education – staying safe online
