

Art & Design, Design and Technology and Music

During Art and Design we will focus on Andy Warhol who was known for using pop art in his work (using popular culture such as the Coca-Cola brand, Campbell's soup and Marilyn Monroe). We will explore his work and use this as inspiration for creating our own works of art. In D&T we will be looking at artist such as Leonardo Da Vinci and exploring how he creates movement in his pictures. In Music, we will be exploring music from around the world and explore, read and compose pieces of music. This will help the children to use graphic scores and record them.

Maths

This term we continue to explore addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will use their knowledge to help them solve one and two step problems. We will continue to develop mental calculation strategies and think about how we can use these to help us solve problems.

ICT

This term we will focus on 'Talking and sharing' this will include discussing how to be safe on the internet. The children will learn how to communicate safely and think about the different ways we can send messages. They will also begin to explore how to write simple algorithms and how to debug simple sets of instructions using BeeBots.

English

In English we will focus on stories by a particular author and the children will create a piece of writing inspired by the author. In our Poetry and Pattern and Rhyme units, the children will also learn how to build vocabulary, experiment with language and looking at sets of rhyming words. The 'Explanation' topic will look at how to write an explanation sentence, extend is using conjunctions and adding detail to their ideas. The children will explore the fantasy genre of writing by planning and creating their own fantasy story. They will read and listen to various stories to inspire their writing.

Geography

In Geography we will focus on the environment of the Amazon Rainforest. Exploring the animals that live there, the counties of the Amazon Rainforest and we will also visit Whipsnade Zoo to look first hand at some of the animals you may find there.

History

Our History topic this term will explore different famous artists from the past and present. The children will learn about the Artist's life and the significance of their work.

Key Stage 1

PE

The children will learn different ways of travelling such as running and hopping as well as teaching the children different ways of throwing. The children will practice different skills in preparation for this Summer's sports day. This term, the children will visit the local swimming pool within their class groups and will be taught in small groups.

PSHE & RE

In PSHE we will explore the topics 'Relationships' and 'Changes' by discussing who is important to us and what makes us proud to be an individual. We will focus on different solutions to resolve a variety of issues such as hurting someone feelings. We will also focus on the importance of having rules, how rules keep us safe and how changes can sometimes be difficult. This term we will be exploring Judaism. In particular, we will be exploring Shabbat, Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. We will be thinking about days that are special to us and traditions we may have with our families.

Science

Our topics for this term will be 'Human Growth' and then 'Plants'. During human growth we will be identifying and naming both internal and external body parts and thinking about what humans need to stay healthy. When we move on to 'Plants', we will be looking at the similarities of growth such as identifying and labelling parts of a plant and thinking about what they need to grow well. We will be having another forest school session focusing on identifying and naming common trees and flowering plants and use this to support our understanding of life cycles. We will also continue to collect data from around the forest school looking at temperature and light in different areas and trying to explaining these differences.
