Art, Design & Technology and Music

In Music we will be exploring sea shanties; learning about why they sang them as well as the chance to create our own. In Art, we will be focussing on landscapes, using lighthouses for the reference for the scenes. We will explore shade to create the backgrounds. In our D&T lessons, we will be researching Puppets and how they function. The children will then design and create a Puppet based on the traditional 'Punch and Judy Show'.

Geography & History

This term we will find out about how the seaside has changed and compare this to past generations. We will be learn about the different human and physical features that can be found at the seaside. Learning about how they are made and why they are there.

Computing

This term we will be developing our skills in using ICT to develop our typing skills, word process, edit and save our work. We will also use digital images to retell stories and capture moments in time. We will also explore how to create moving digital images by creating our own short animation.

Maths

This term we continue to cover addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will use the knowledge we already have to help us solve one and two step problems. We will continue to develop mental calculation strategies and think about how we can use these to help us solve problems.

Key Stage 1 - Summer 2022



PF

In PE we will be exploring how to move in different ways looking at different ways to dodge and jump.

In outdoor PE we will be exploring the concept of attacking and defending in the context of a game.

PSHE & RE

This term in PSHE, we will be learning about 'Relationships'. We will be identifying members of our families and understand that there are lots of different types of families. We will also be exploring how to be a good friend and learn to recognise qualities in others. good In RE, we will focus on Judaism and in particular the 'Covenant' and 'Rites of Passage'. These units will explore how Jewish people express their relationship with God, traditions, Bat and Bar Mitzvahs and share stories from their holy book the 'Torah'.

English

Our key areas of continued focus in writing are sentence structure, punctuation, spelling and developing vocabulary. Phonics lessons will take place daily and the children's phonological knowledge will be extended. We will also be exploring how to write a recount and learning about the past tense. As well as thinking about how we can use our knowledge of information to help us present information.

Science

This term, we will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals, including fish, mammals, amphibians, reptiles and birds. We will also be exploring the structure of these common animals. We will learn about the definitions and differences between animals that are herbivores, omnivores and carnivores. As well as thinking about how animals are affected by the seasons and how they adapt.
