

MATHS

This term we will focus on number fluency, matching numeral to quantity. We will begin to show an interest in mathematical word problems and learn positional language.

EXPRESSIVE ART AND DESIGN

We will continue to dance, sing and perform nursery rhymes and familiar songs and experiment with sound and musical instruments. We will be using a variety of tools and medias to promote junk modelling around our topics and interests.

LITERACY

We will continue to learn our phase 2 phonic sounds and letter names. We will also continue to learn to recognise, read and write our own names. Adults will focus on story telling and story scribing for the children to promote the development and knowledge of story structure.



COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will be starting to re tell stories with repeated phrases and actions using Pie Corbett methods. This will help us to build our vocabulary and learn to speak in more complex sentences, using different tenses.
