

Art & Design and Music

In **Art**, we will be finding out about different forms of art in public spaces, and develop our own ideas for eye-catching street art through sketching and annotating. We will discuss how street art polarises opinion, when and where it is acceptable, and how it can improve or damage public spaces. In **Music**, we will be listening to and learning about the Gamelan - traditional Indonesian ensemble music. We will be using this to create our own cyclic patterns. We will also be learning the songs for our Summer Production and working on our performance technique.

Maths

This term we will be learning about ratio and proportion and applying this to real life situations. We will also be learning to interpret and evaluate information presented in charts and tables. We will continue to practise using a range of skills when solving problems involving the four operations.

History

This term we will be looking at British History focusing on the Anglo-Saxons. We will focus on exploring the impact of invasions through a historical case study.

Geography

We will be exploring national geographical issues including flooding, global warming, renewable energy and climate change.

PE

In **Athletics** this term, we will be focussing on running, throwing and field events in preparation for Sports Day. In **Games** we will be learning the basic skills of cricket and rounders and will focus on working well as a team and the importance of this in sporting events.

Events

Summer term is always busy and will see a number of sporting events taking place. This term Year 6's will also be completing their end of key stage assessments. At the end of the term, we look forward to sharing UKS2's production.

PSHE & RE

In **RE**, we will be looking at Islam in more detail including learning about how their belief in Akhirah, influences Muslims to do their best to lead a good life. We will also recognise what motivates and influences us to lead good a good life.

In **PSHE**, we will be thinking about different relationships. We will be exploring what it means to be a good friend and what this might look like.

English

Macbeth

One of our key English topics will be fiction from our heritage, where we will study Shakespeare's classic Macbeth. We will carry out a detailed study into the Scottish king's eventual downfall, weaving drama, reading and eventually writing our own versions.

Street Child

This term we will be studying the book 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty. We will write character descriptions and write in the role of different characters.

Poetry

In our poetry topic, we will be exploring our own responses to issues raised by poverty.



Science

In Science, we will begin our topic on materials by sorting and classifying them according to different properties. This will then lead us to consider why certain materials are used for different purposes; we will also be conducting many enquiry-based lessons on reversible and chemical changes, looking at dissolving, filtration and combustion to name but a few.

Modern Foreign Languages

In German, our topic will be 'Ein Besuch im Café', looking at food, drink, how to order and pay at restaurants and cafes, as well as designing our own ice creams – lecker!

In French, this term's topic will finish our work on clothing before starting work on habitats and the outside world.
