

Art & Design and Music

In **Art**, we will be finding out about different forms of art in public spaces, and develop our own ideas for eye-catching street art through sketching and annotating. We will discuss how street art polarises opinion, when and where it is acceptable, and how it can improve or damage public spaces. In **Music**, we will be listening to and learning about the Gamelan - traditional Indonesian ensemble music. We will also be learning songs and working on our performance technique.

Maths

This term we will continue to practise using a range of skills when solving problems involving the four operations. We will also be covering different forms of data handling using a variety of graphs and charts.

History

This term we will be looking at the Victorian era focusing on Queen Victoria. We will explore the impact of technological and societal changes that occurred during this time.

Geography

We will be exploring national geographical issues including flooding, global warming, renewable energy and climate change.

English

Macbeth

One of our key English topics will be fiction from our heritage, where we will study Shakespeare's classic Macbeth. We will carry out a detailed study into the Scottish king's eventual downfall, weaving drama, reading and eventually writing our own versions.

Street Child

This term we will be studying the book 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty. We will write character descriptions and write in the role of different characters.

Poetry

In our poetry topic, we will explore how poetry can help us to understand and respond to emotive and often contentious issues and can help us 'find a voice'.




Science

In Science, we will begin our topic on materials by sorting and classifying them according to different properties. This will lead us to consider why certain materials are used for different purposes; we will also be conducting many enquiry-based lessons on reversible and chemical changes, looking at dissolving, filtration and combustion to name but a few.

PE

In **Athletics** this term, we will be focusing on running, throwing and field events in preparation for Sports Day. In **Games** we will be consolidating our skills in rounders and will focus on working well as a team and the importance of this in sporting events.



PSHE & RE

In **RE**, we will be looking at Islam in more detail this term, including learning about how their belief in Akhirah, influences Muslims to do their best to lead a good life. We will also recognise what motivates and influences us to lead good a good life.

In **PSHE**, we will be thinking about different relationships. We will be exploring what it means to be a good friend and what this might look like.

Modern Foreign Languages

In **German**, our topic will be 'Ein Besuch im Café', looking at food, drink, how to order and pay at restaurants and cafes, as well as designing our own ice creams – lecker!

In **French**, we will be covering 'le weekend' which will involve using the time and discussing what we do in our free time.
