This week, Year 6's chairs quit! We have written newspaper reports about this strange event; why not ask us where they went?



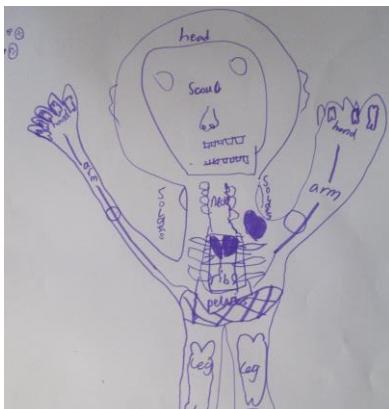
KS1
