- I like English because we get to look at different things like poems and stories.



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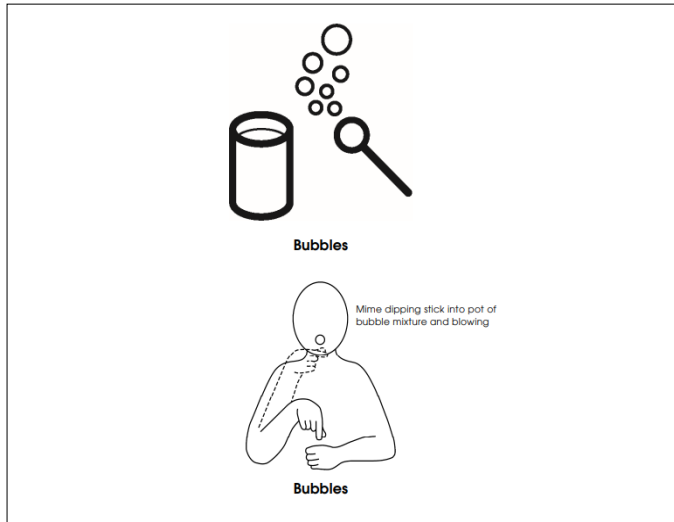
