KS1

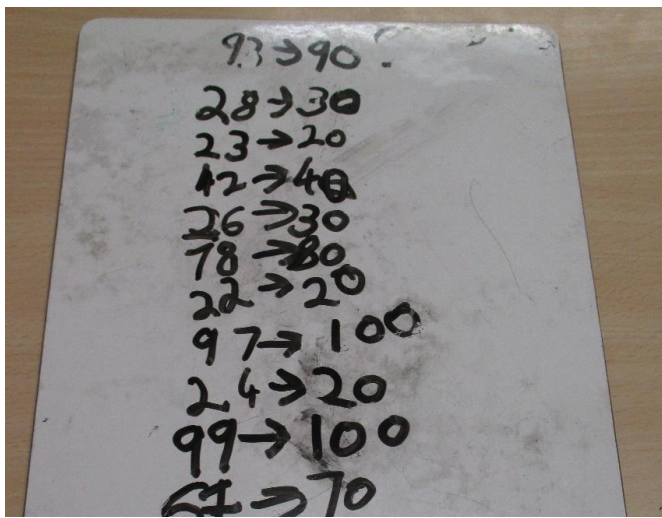
We have been using resources to help us in our Maths lessons. We made numbers on a tens frame and discussed what we noticed, for example who had the smallest or largest number and why.
