



What we have been up to

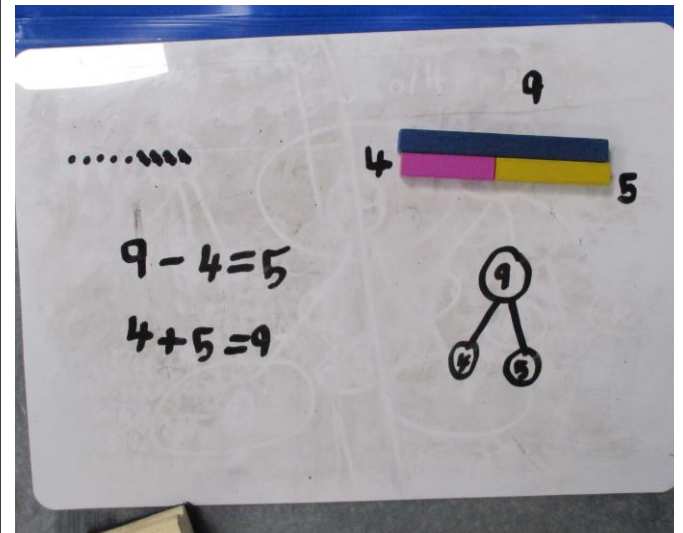
UKS2

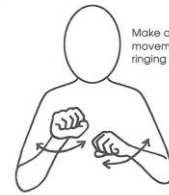
### Mrs Miller's Message
