ALL pupils leaving primary school **physically literate** and with the **knowledge Skills & motivation** necessary to equip them for a **healthy, active lifestyle** and **lifelong participation** in physical activity and sport

At Wheatcroft Primary School we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and well-being of the children. In addition, it is considered that an innovative and varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all children. Our Sports Premium funding has enabled us to build a team of PE specialists who ensure quality provision for all the children across the school from Nursery to Year 6. The team is led by Mr Wilkie who is well supported by Mr Marks (Teaching Assistant) and Mr Smith (Sports Apprentice)

Last year we were delighted to achieve the Gold Kitemark Award showing recognition of the good development of PE within our school.

We will monitor the impact of the funding available against the following 5 indicators

1. the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick starting healthy active lifestyles
2. the profile of PE & Sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all teaching staff in teaching PE & Sport
4. broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils within their school experience
5. increased participation in competitive sport

Train all year 5 children in play leading & increase the resources required to enhance physical play during lunch times	£200	Increase the amount of opportunity for all children to participate in a physical activity every day
Year 4 children to develop a sports programme for the Reception children	£200	Reception children will be given more opportunities to develop their physical skills including fine & gross motor skills
Nutrition club food resources & travel costs linked to visits from local sports people	£300	Inspire children to eat well and understand the importance of a healthy life style and how this is linked to sports professionals
Enhance & develop sports day to become more competitive with more athletic events & activities Medals, stickers & certificates for sports day	£400	Raise the profile of Sports Day encouraging children to achieve their best and be competitive in a positive way.

Buy sets of PE teaching cards to support teachers in the teaching of the key skills	£400	The teaching of PE will be good to outstanding and consistent throughout the school
Buy storage baskets to display the equipment making it easier and more accessible therefore used to enhance PE lessons & activities. Resources in the PE containers will be organised & used more effectively within lessons	£200	PE equipment will be accessible to all and more will be used more effectively to support the teaching & learning of PE
Update the football & netball kits as well as match balls, football & netball posts and court markings	£1200	Good attendance of clubs to ensure A and B teams. Good quality equipment that will last all weathers. Team to look more professional and feel confident during matches & events. Logos and sponsorship will highlight other sporting opportunities
Upskill staff in the teaching & assessment of PE through staff meetings and INSET from the sports team	£300	PE teaching will be good across the school. Practice will be consistent.
Promote PE through display and flyers	£100	PE profile to be raised around the school for children, staff, parents & Governors
Sports Ambassadors training & t-shirts Including staff representation	£16	Sports ambassadors to support the promotion of PE through various events. Profile to be enhanced and children inspired to participate
Transport, resources & staff time for friendly matches to be organised with other schools	£50	Children will be given more opportunities to play against other schools to develop confidence when playing against other teams
Netball tournament	£50	Children will be given the opportunity to compete against other schools and develop a sense of team work
G&T PE day	£100	More opportunities for more able children in PE to develop and enhance their skills and then use these to upskill some potential peers
Umpire & referee training for the PE team including football and netball	£300	Staff will be able to prepare the teams for matches. More matches will be able to go ahead with trained umpire/referee
Swimming – year 5&6 water safety. Years 5 &6 completion of standards	£200	More children will be given the opportunity to learn the life skill of swimming.
